Joseph received the prestigious Peter Davis Award

Last week Joseph (5/6 R) was presented with the Peter Davis Outstanding Athlete Award. The criteria for the award states that a Year 6 student must have represented Sydney West at a minimum of three State Carnivals and that only one boy and one girl per year will be chosen.

Joseph has represented Sydney West and NSW in five different sports in 2015: AFL, Rugby Union, Rugby League, Basketball and Athletics. At the National Athletics Carnival Joseph broke the high-jump record and is now the Australian record holder with a jump of 1.78 metres.

Congratulations are extended to Joseph, a talented young man and a genuine sportsman on and off the field.
