on Thursday 24th March, from 11.30am.**

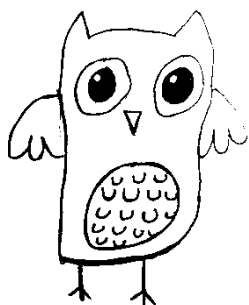
