These forms need to be completed and returned to their classroom teacher by 13 March 2017.



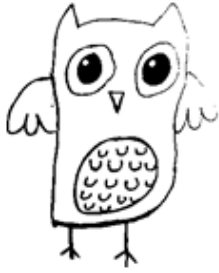
Glenmore Park High School Open Night

Outdated signs have been removed – but the parking rules stay the same

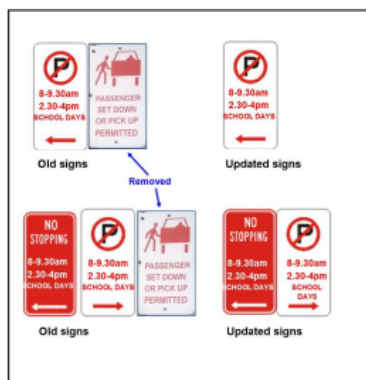
Extra signs have been on display next to the 'No Parking' signs at the school.

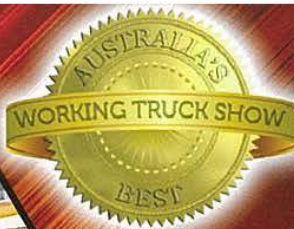

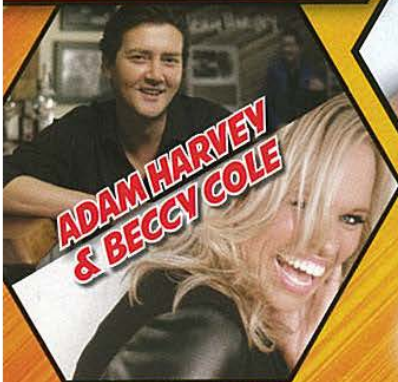
